RULES AND REGULATIONS

Games will be 5 innings. NO NEW INNING WILL START AFTER 90 MINUTES.

Must complete 3 innings to be scored as an official game.

Innings 1-4 are 5 runs or 3 outs, inning 5 is open.

Bat entire roster, unlimited substitutions.

9 players on defense. Players must play 2 defensive innings.

Pitching distance is 50 feet.

No lead offs. Runners may steal at the release of the pitch only from and to any base. If a runner leaves too early, they will be called out. This will help with allowing the pitchers to focus more on pitching and the game to be scored more by hits than walks and steals.

No stealing home. Runner must be forced or batted in.

Infield fly rule is in effect. The rule applies only when there are fewer than 2 outs, and there is a force play (there are runners at 1st, 1st and 2nd, or the bases are loaded.) In these situations, if a fly ball is in fair play, and in the umpire's judgment it is catch able by an infielder with ordinary effort, the umpire shall call "infield fly," and the batter will be out regardless of whether the ball is actually caught in flight.

Sliding is allowed. All runners must slide on close plays or they will be called out. Please stress this to your players for safety reasons!

HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL BATTERS AND RUNNERS.

Batters will be called out (after one warning) for thrown bat.

All players are eligible to pitch but no more than 5 innings per week. For the end of season tournament, players may pitch 7 total innings.

Team listed first on schedule takes the field first.

SPORTSMANSHIP IS A REQUIREMENT TO PLAY AND COACH GAC BALL.  
DISRESPECTFUL AND UNRULY BEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.  
DO NOT CHARGE THE FIELD, DO NOT ARGUE WITH THE UMPIRES, DO NOT  
DISPLAY INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR. IF ANY OF THESE RULES ARE ABUSED,  
YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FIELDS. A SPECIAL MEETING WITH THE  
DIRECTOR AND GAC BOARD WILL BE MANDATORY FOR A COACH/PLAYER TO  
RESUME PARTICIPATION.
